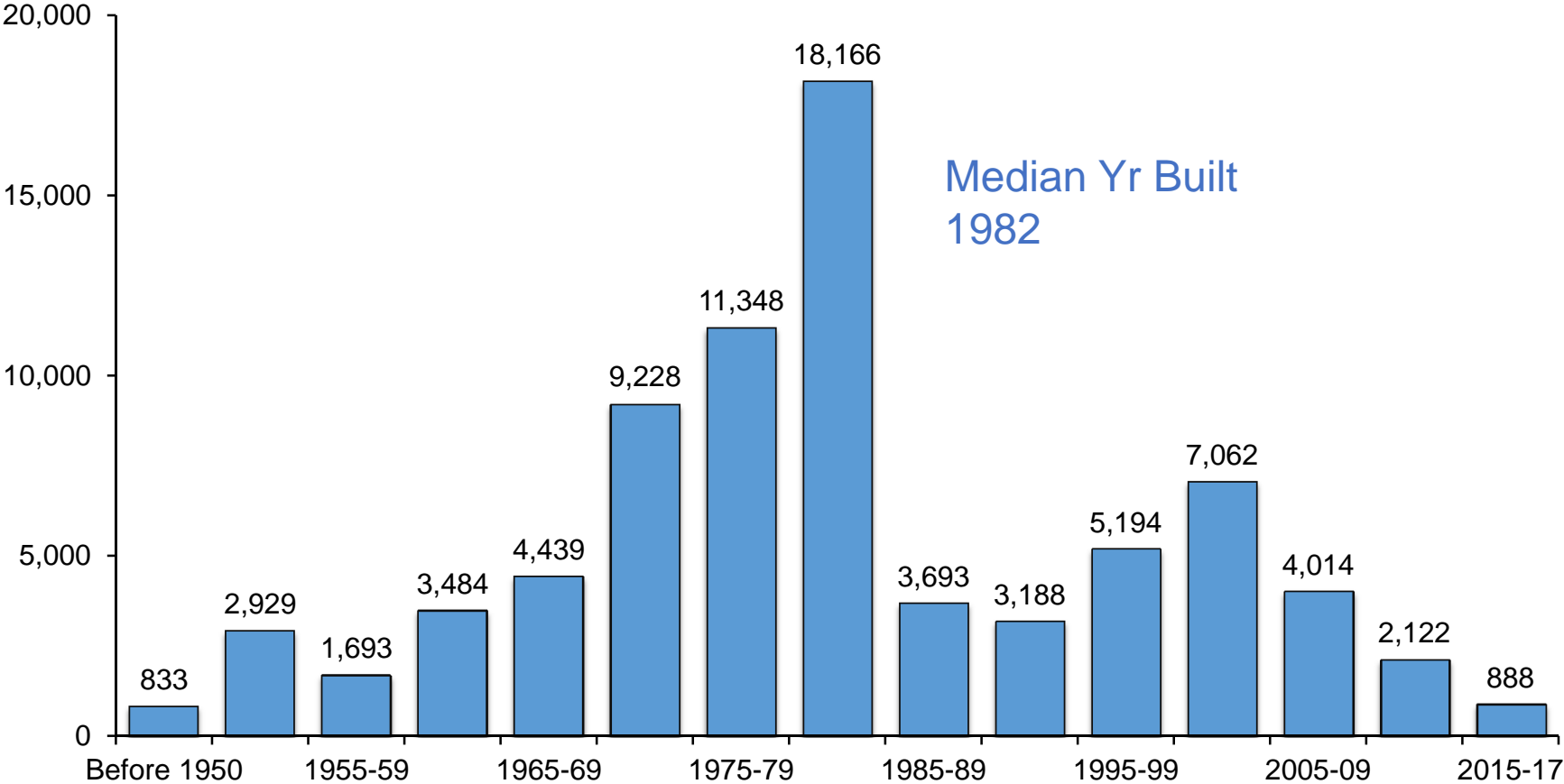
Duties include participating in community dialogue, studying best practices, supporting new and different housing options and making informed decisions.

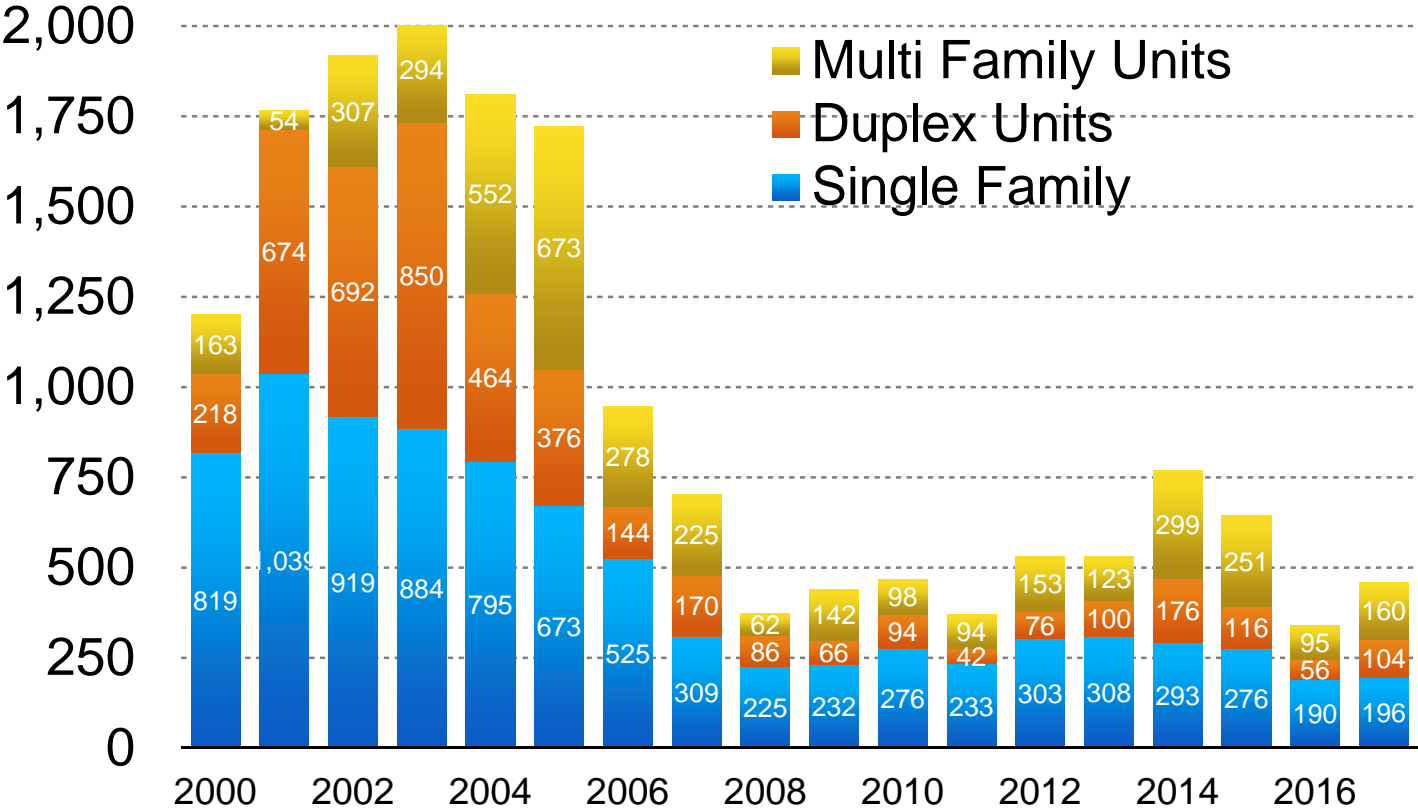


Anchorage Housing Units by Year Built
