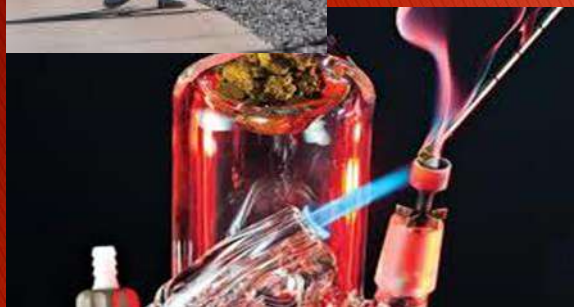


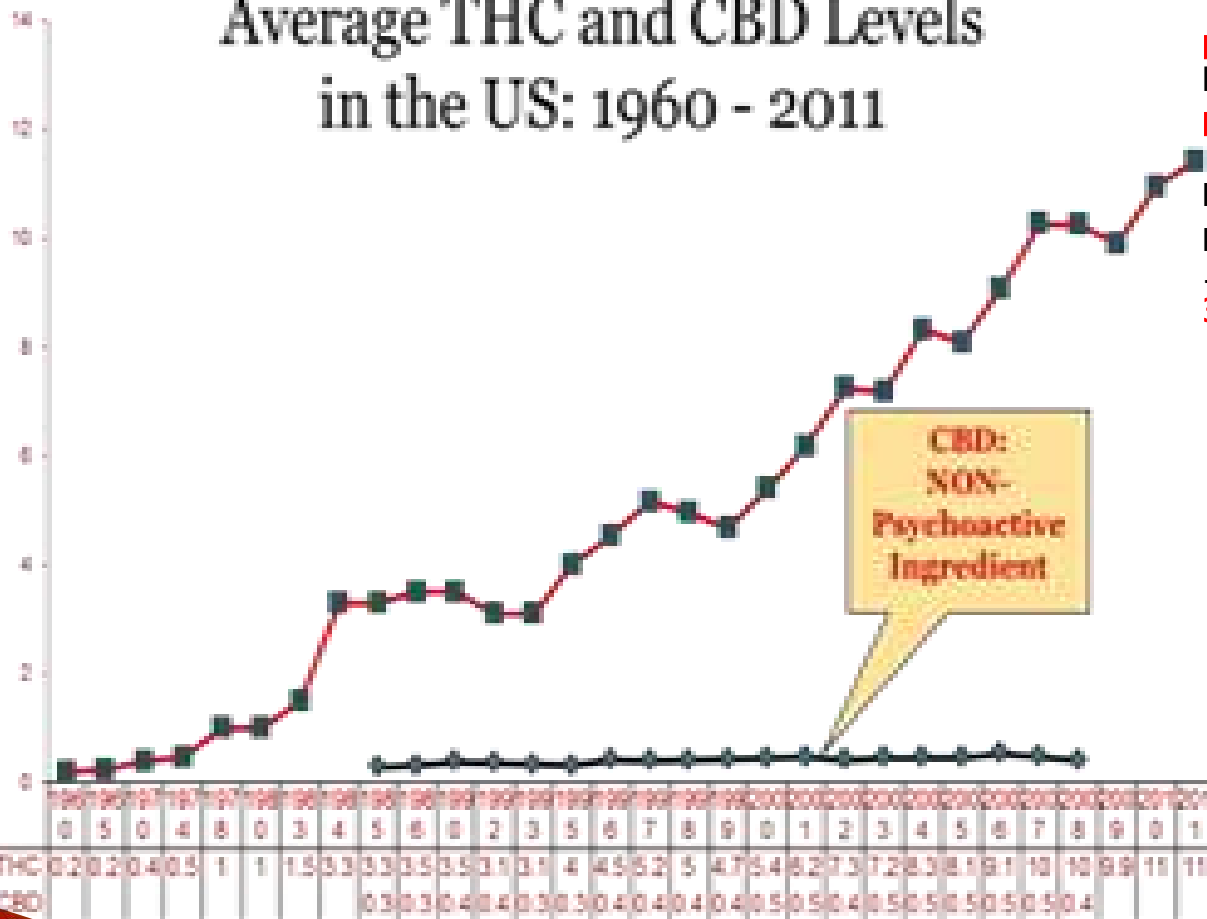

Average THC and CBD Levels in the US: 1960 - 2011



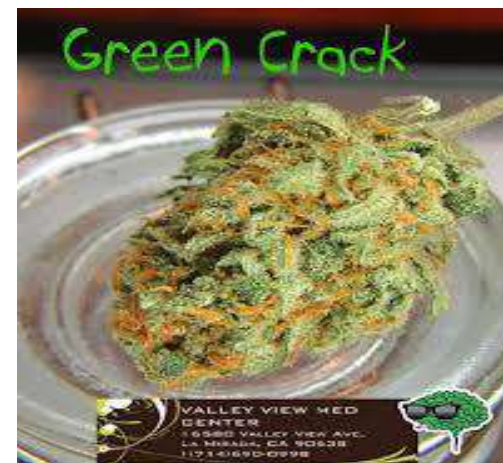

In **2012**, the most recent year in which testing has been completed, the average THC concentration was **12.3 percent**.

That would be 300 percent higher...than **1992** levels, when the average was **3.08 percent**. And it would be 800 percent higher...than the average level of **0.98 percent** found in **1976**.

How high could the THC content potentially go? One specimen, seized ...was found to have a THC content of **37.2 percent**.

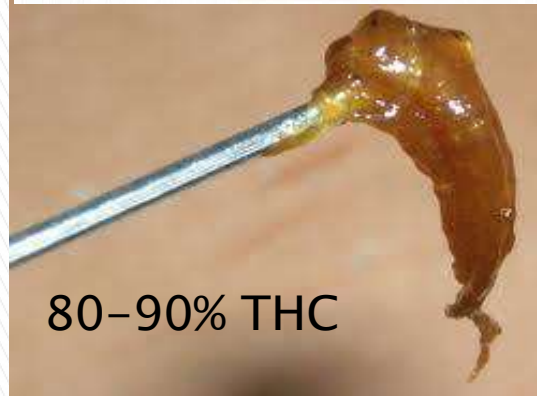

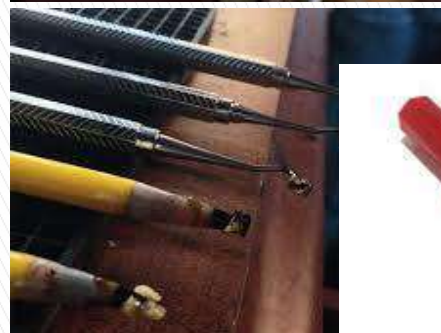

Extreme Definition of “Marijuana Accessories”

(“Shall not” be an offense to possess, use, transport, marijuana accessories)

“ ‘Marijuana accessories’ means any equipment, products or materials of any kind which are used... in planting...growing... manufacturing, compounding, converting, producing, processing...vaporizing, or containing marijuana or for ingesting, inhaling or otherwise introducing marijuana into the human body.”

Too Costly to Health



- ▶ Kris Kirk, 44 year old mother of 3, was **shot and killed** by her husband while she was on the phone with a 911 operator. Her husband had eaten “Karma Kandy Orange Ginger.”
- ▶ Levy Thamba, 19 year old student, **jumped to his death** from a hotel balcony after eating a marijuana edible.
- ▶ “26 people have reported **poisonings** from marijuana edibles between 1/1/14 and 4/15/15 in Colorado.” Al Bronstein, Medical Director of Rocky Mountain Poison and Drug Center



Increased Risk for Psychosis and Development of Psychotic Symptoms

- ▶ “In conclusion, the available evidence support the hypothesis that cannabis is an **independent risk factor, both for psychosis and the development of psychotic symptoms.**”
- ▶ (“Cannabis as a risk factor for psychosis: systematic review,”
- ▶ Semple, et.al.(2005))



Cannabis use and Childhood Trauma Interact Additively

- ▶ Replication in two independent population-based samples that **childhood maltreatment and cannabis use synergistically impact on psychosis risk.** (Konings, et. al. (2012))
- ▶ “...the **psychosis**–inducing effects of cannabis were stronger in individuals exposed to earlier sexual or physical mistreatment”



“Cannabis during pregnancy endangers fetal brain development” (Science Daily 1/27/14)

- ▶ “The study highlights that consuming Cannabis during pregnancy clearly results in defective development of nerve cells of the **cerebral cortex**, the part of the brain that orchestrates higher cognitive functions and drives memory formation.

Too Costly to Education

“For those who met criteria for cannabis dependence..., **the average drop in IQ was 8 points** (between age 13 and 38)...

The decline in IQ included all four indices of IQ: working memory, processing speed, perceptual reasoning and verbal comprehension”

(“Persistent cannabis users show neuropsychological decline from childhood to midlife,” Meier, et. al.(2012)) ruled out pre-existing difference in IQ; also showed that those who used marijuana heavily before age 18 showed mental decline even after they quit consuming.



Adverse Effects of Short-Term Use and Long-Term or Heavy Use of Marijuana

New England Journal of Medicine, June 5, 2014

▶ Effects of short-term use

- Impaired short-term memory, making it difficult to learn and to retain information
- Impaired motor coordination, interfering with driving skills and increasing the risk of injuries
- Altered judgment, increasing the risk of sexual behaviors that facilitate the transmission of sexually transmitted diseases
- In high doses, paranoia and psychosis



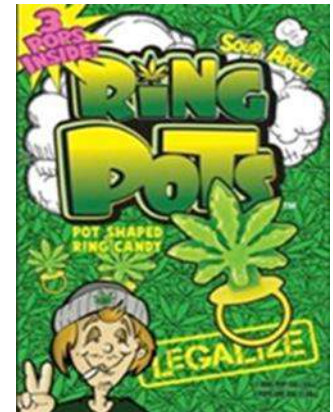

Adverse Effects of Short-Term Use and Long-Term or Heavy Use of Marijuana

▶ Effects of long-term or heavy use

- **Addiction** (in about 9% of users overall, 17% of those who begin use in adolescence, and **25 to 50% of those who are daily users**)*)"the evidence clearly indicates that long-term marijuana use can lead to addiction.")
- **Altered brain development***
- **Poor educational outcome, with increased likelihood of dropping out of school***
- **Cognitive impairment, with lower IQ among those who were frequent users during adolescence***
- **Diminished life satisfaction and achievement** (determined on the basis of subjective and objective measures as compared with such ratings in the general population)*
- Symptoms of chronic bronchitis
- Increased risk of chronic psychosis disorders (including schizophrenia) in persons with a predisposition to such disorders

- ▶ **“However, the effects of a drug (legal or illegal) on individual health are determined not only by its pharmacologic properties but also by its availability and social acceptability.**
- ▶ **In this respect, legal drugs (alcohol and tobacco) offer a sobering perspective, accounting for the greatest burden of disease associated with drugs, not because they are more dangerous than illegal drugs but because their legal status allows for more widespread exposure.”**

Very Costly to State

The State of Alaska estimates the cost of implementing this initiative at around **\$7 million**.

Other (likely annually recurring) costs included in this figure:

- \$1,100,000** Increased substance use, dependency and addictions treatments; increased mental health treatment services.
- \$400,000** Increased physical health services.
- \$140,000** Increased enforcement of marijuana access by youth.
- \$250,000** Increased child protection services for young children in homes with regular and persistent marijuana users.
- \$200,000** Increased juvenile justice services.
- \$594,400** Increased Statewide Drug Enforcement Unit trooper investigators to target diversion and exportation of marijuana (AST predicts illegal commercial marijuana growing operations will continue to exist and legalization could increase opportunities).
- \$607,500** Launching a public education campaign on the dangers of driving under the influence ("the number of individuals driving under the influence of marijuana is expected to increase.") Plus other costs of DUI enforcement.



More Costs: Alaska Chiefs of Police

- ▶ Taxpayers in Alaska's small towns and cities face **\$6,000,000** in unanticipated costs if the marijuana initiative passes this year.
- ▶ In a recent survey conducted by the association, 75% of chiefs in Alaska said their agencies would not have the resources necessary to deal with the potential law enforcement impact of marijuana legalization



And So Many More Unintended Consequences Costs

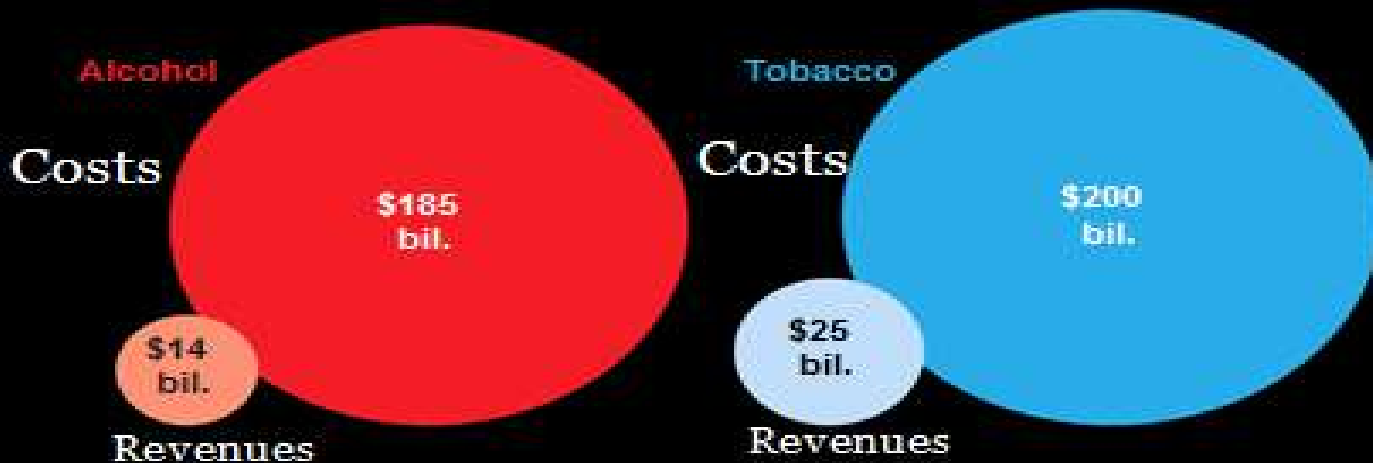
When states promote something that is not good for people, they need to be prepared for “unintended consequences.” (Christian Science Monitor, 7/26/14)

- Homeless rates have increased in Denver
 - (Denver Post 7/25/14)
- Crime rate has increased in Denver by almost 7%
 - (National Incident Based Reporting System)
- The black market is thriving, especially in economically disadvantaged communities (“Inside Colorado’s Flourishing Segregated Black Market for Pot,” Washington Post 7/30/14)

Effects of Marijuana and Pilot Performance

- ▶ Ten experienced licensed private pilots trained for 8 hours on a flight simulator landing task
- ▶ Each smoked a THC cigarette (19 mg)
- ▶ 24 hours later their mean performance on the flight task showed trends toward **impairment in all variables, some tasks showed significant impairment**
- ▶ Despite the deficits, the **pilots reported no awareness of impaired performance.**

Legalizing Will Increase Use Among Teens

- ▶ Nearly two-thirds (65%) of teens who reported using marijuana at least once in their lifetime said that legalizing the drug would make them more likely to use it.
- ▶ In addition, more than three-fourths (78%) of heavy marijuana users reported that legalizing the drug would make them more likely to use it.

(Center for Substance Abuse Research from The Partnership for a Drug-Free America and the MetLife Foundation, The Partnership Attitude Tracking Study (PATs): Teens and Parents, 2013.)




Impact on Driving

- ▶ Driver culpability studies show that drivers testing positive to marijuana “are **significantly more likely to be responsible for fatal car crashes** than are drug-free drivers.”
(University of Washington ADAI)
- ▶ “the acute effect of moderate or higher doses of marijuana impairs the skills related to safe driving and injury risk”, particularly “attention, tracking and psychomotor skills.”
